

Admission with International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma **OR** Cambridge International Examination (CIE) results (completed in NZ)

Who should use this form?

The form attached is to be used by all students (domestic and international) studying in New Zealand High Schools who intend to qualify for admission to a degree programme at the University of Canterbury on the basis of:

- The International Baccalaureate Diploma or
- The University of Cambridge International Examination (CIE)

International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB)

Applicants qualify for admission by achieving the International Baccalaureate Diploma.

Permission should be given for the staff of the University of Canterbury to view their results online. This may be done by contacting the International Baccalaureate Organisation through the High School officer concerned. If this is not done applicants will have to produce their original International Baccalaureate Diplomas.

University of Cambridge International Examinations (CIE)

Applicants qualify for admission through the University of Cambridge International Examinations (CIE) A or AS levels by achieving:

- a minimum of 120 points on the UCAS Tariff (<http://www.ucas.com/candq/tariff/index.html>)
- and a minimum grade of D in each of at least 3 subjects equivalent to those in the approved list (<http://www.nzqa.govt.nz/ncea/acrp/secondary/6/631.html>).
- The literacy and numeracy requirements may be fulfilled respectively by an E grade or better in AS English and a D grade or better in IGCSE mathematics.
- Alternatively the literacy and numeracy requirements may be met by fulfilling the NCEA University Entrance literacy and/or numeracy requirements (However, NCEA subject results may NOT be substituted for CIE subject results).

Applicants must provide their Centre Number (examinations centre) and their Candidate Number for each session of the examinations.

Level of Admission

Applicants are normally granted admission ad eundem statum at entrance level to the University of Canterbury. Applicants with exceptionally high grades may be awarded advanced standing by some departments of the university in relevant subjects.

Enrolment

Students in New Zealand High schools may apply to enrol prior to receiving their IB/CIE results. The entrance qualification question should be answered "Admission ad eundem statum at entrance level". Applications will be held by the International Office until IB and CIE results are released at which time the International Office will issue letters to all successful applicants. A few subjects have limitations of entry at first year level. It is important to note the deadlines for these subjects in the enrolment Handbook and to apply to enrol in time for the deadlines.

International students should apply to enrol before they go home for the holidays.
