## How do I find out about scholarships?

## How do I know if I am eligible for a scholarship?

Check the regulations on the application form to see if you meet the eligibility criteria (eg subject/course, level, citizenship, age, gender, ethnicity, school, region, etc).

Apply for all the scholarships you are eligible for, as it is often possible to hold more than one scholarship each year.

## What if I am going on a gap year?

If you are planning to go overseas on a gap year, you should check whether the regulations require you to apply for the scholarship before you depart, or, if you are successful, whether you can defer it.

## How do I apply for a scholarship?

Application forms for UC scholarships are usually available eight weeks prior to the closing date and can be downloaded from our web page [www.ucscholarships.co.nz](http://www.ucscholarships.co.nz) or from the College or Department web pages.

Other organisations also offer scholarships that UC students can apply for. Check with your school or local community groups for further information.

## Scholarships for all disciplines

### UC Undergraduate Entrance Scholarships

For students who are completing NCEA Level 3 or equivalent University Entrance qualifications no application is required, however, interest can be registered via the UC Contact Centre or the Scholarships website (up to \$3,000 cash).

### UC Emerging Leaders' Scholarships (Category A) – 1 Sep 2011

**All-Round Excellence Awards.** For academic achievement and leadership, plus sporting, cultural and community involvement (at least 40 x \$5,000).

### UC Emerging Leaders' Scholarships (Category B) – 1 Sep 2011

**Head Boy/Head Girl Awards.** Please refer to the Scholarships website for geographical eligibility (up to 40 x \$5,000).

### UC Emerging Leaders' Scholarships (Category C) – 1 Sep 2011

**Māori & Pasifika Awards.** For students of Māori or Pasifika descent (at least 2 x \$5,000).

**UC Emerging Leaders' Scholarships  
(Category E) – 1 Sep 2011**

**Sports Awards.** For outstanding sporting achievement (at least 10 x \$5,000).

**UC Alumni Association Scholarships  
– 1 Sep 2011**

For students demonstrating an awareness of the value of an alumni community (2 x \$5,000).

**Riccarton Rotary Youth Trust Scholarship  
– 1 Oct 2011**

For a Canterbury school leaver facing major financial challenges to entering tertiary education (up to \$40,000 in total over 4 years).

**Bright Start Scholarships – 19 Nov 2011**

For South Island residents, north of the Waitaki River, facing financial and/or personal challenges. Applicants may be school leavers or mature students (first-year fees). This scholarship will be offered if funds permit.

**UC Dux Scholarships – 10 Dec 2011**

School nomination. Please refer to the Scholarships website for geographical eligibility (up to \$5,000 each).

**HMNZS Canterbury Scholarship – 31 Jan 2012**

For a Canterbury resident (\$10,000).

## **Scholarships for International Students**

**UC International Student Undergraduate  
Four-Year Scholarship – 1 Oct 2011**

For top achieving students commencing a preparatory programme or undergraduate degree, who can demonstrate leadership and contribution to the school and/or community (up to 24 x \$20,000 per annum towards tuition fees).

**Category B.** For BCom students from any New Zealand secondary school (up to 20 x \$5,000).

**Management Science and Operations Research Undergraduate Scholarship – 1 Sep 2011**

For a BCom majoring in Management Science and Operations Management (\$5,000).

**UC Commerce Ambassadorships – 31 Jan 2012**

For international fee-paying BCom students from any New Zealand secondary school. Includes international travel up to \$3,000, and a College of Business and Economics Internship valued at \$5,550. Ambassadors are required to complete up to two 'UC student experience' presentations (up to 5 x \$8,550).
