

Your next steps:

- Contact NZQA to confirm how many credits you are missing, and in which subjects.
- If NZQA confirms you are short 8 credits or less, contact LPHS to confirm if they can support you to complete the missing credits.
- Sign up to Logan Park's Summer School, then forward your enrolment confirmation email to provisional-admission@canterbury.ac.nz.
- Once UC confirms you are eligible, you will receive an email with details of your provisional admission to UC, and you will be able to complete your UC enrolment.
- Submit your NCEA work to LPHS by Friday 13 February 2026 (or earlier if LPHS gives you an earlier deadline).
- 6 Start your UC studies in Semester One.
- Forward the email from LPHS that confirms you've achieved your catch-up credits to provisional-admission@ canterbury.ac.nz by Friday 27 February 2026.

What happens next:

UC will check your Summer School results and confirm whether you have achieved UE by the end of Week Two of Semester One (Friday 27 February).

If you have achieved UE, you will be able to continue with your studies at UC.

If you have not, you will be withdrawn from your UC courses and we will advise you of your options and plan a study pathway with you.
