









Master of Coin (Chief Financial Officer) Job Description

The Master of Coin is head of the treasury and finances of the kingdom. This role acts as chief financial advisor to the King and involves keeping account of the receipts and expenditures from the royal treasury, and supervising tax collection.

Stockbroker

Job Description

A stockbroker manages financial portfolios on behalf of clients. They research financial markets, consult investment analysts, and monitor clients investment.

Recruitment Specialist

Job Description

A recruitment specialist is responsible for managing the recruitment and selection (or sorting!) of new talent into the organisation.

System Security Specialist

Job Description

A system security specialist protects an organisation's network and databases. This can involve managing spyware and virus protection software to protect against hostile entities.

International Business Advisor

Job Description

An international business advisor consults on foreign transactions and inter-kingdom business strategy. This role can involve gathering and evaluating a range of information from many sources.

Team Leader

Job Description

A team leader must supervise and keep team members in line, and coordinate and carryout strategies or plans of attack - all while taking into consideration workplace safety and occupational hazards (such as orcs).

Creative Director

Job Description

Creative directors oversee the formulation and development of advertising campaigns. This role involves using their creative expertise to turn the clients vision into a tangible and deliverable product.

Operations and Production Manager

Job Description

An operations and production manager is in charge of supervising and assessing the production process, as well as managing organisational logistics and distribution of 'the product'.

Entrepreneur

Job Description

An entrepreneur can take on many responsibilities. These can include the planning and development of new products, client relationship building and creation of business strategies.

Financial Lawyer

Job Description

This job can involve the examination of illegal financial activity and analysing financial information and data for evidence.

Lawyer

Job Description

A lawyer appears and conducts proceedings in court on behalf of a client. Cases can be civil, criminal or family oriented.

Police Officer

Job Description

A police officer can specialise in a variety of areas including anti-terrorism, diplomatic protection and dealing with armed (or armless) offenders.
