

BSNS228 International Study Tours Info Session







- Credit: 15 point BSNS elective (BSNS228)
- Cost: BSNS228 tuition fee (loanable) plus \$2,500 fee which covers flights, accommodation, and programmerelated activities (food and other expenses are additional)
- Funding conditions: The \$2,500 fee is subsidised fee using the UC Business School Global Experience Award. This award only applies to BCom students who have <u>not</u> already received the Global Experience Award. If you are from another a degree or have already received the Global Experience Award, the fee will be \$4,000.
- Eligibility: 120 points at UC, including ECON104 and a further 15 points from Schedule V of the BCom
- Limited enrolment course: 15 students minimum, 20 students maximum.
 The basis of selection will be demonstrated academic achievement in the form of an applicant's GPA and the quality of the personal statement. Equal consideration will be given to both criteria.
- Learning objectives of the course make it generally unsuitable for students from the countries visited

- Reflect on and develop your capability to function effectively in culturally diverse situations;
- Describe the key features of the host country's economy and its role in the global economy;
- Compare and contrast the economies of the host country and New Zealand and their respective roles in the Asia-Pacific region or wider global economy;
- Discuss the main characteristics of the business environment and culture in the host country;
- Reflect on the similarities and differences between the business practices and cultures in the host country and
 New Zealand, including Māori and Pacific business practices and cultures;
- Analyse the opportunities and challenges for organisations wishing to conduct business in the host country;
- Apply relevant theoretical frameworks and practical knowledge in undertaking a project relating to a specific industry or opportunity in the host country.

About Malaysia


- Muslim-majority, multicultural country (Malay 50%, Malaysian Chinese 23%, Malaysian Indian 7%)

- Hub for international businesses and trade


About Guangzhou
