MOU for All of Government Imagery KiwImage

Memorandum of Understanding

Between Land Information New Zealand (LINZ), known as the Data Custodian of KiwImage.

And the **University of Canterbury** known as the **Partner Agency**.

Background

- KiwImage was an All of Government project to capture accurate, high resolution imagery of New Zealand and the Offshore Islands. The project was group funded by various Government Agencies, Territorial & Regional Authorities, State Owned Enterprises (SOE), Emergency Services, Crown Research Institutes, and Universities.
- 2. The imagery was captured by DigitalGlobe using the Quickbird II satellite.
- 3. The project came to a close on 6 Dec 2012. No further imagery will be captured as part of this project
- 4. KiwImage was purchased on an All of Government licence and is now available to all Government Agencies, Territorial & Regional Authorities, State Owned Enterprises (SOE), Emergency Services, Crown Research Institutes, and Universities on acceptance of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).
- 5. Land Information New Zealand (on behalf of NZDF) has informally taken on the role of Data Custodian of KiwImage (even though the contractual responsibility for Data Custodian still sits with NZDF). However for the purposes of this MOU, any reference to the Data Custodian shall be a reference to LINZ.
- 6. On 22 February 2008 Digital Globe entered into a contract with New Zealand Defence Force (NZDF) which enables NZDF to use Kiwi Image and sublicence the product to other Government Agencies." That licence is still in place and under that licence NZDF is the Data Custodian.

Understanding

7. The **Partner Agency** agrees to the terms and conditions contained in this MOU.

Coverage

8. As the KiwImage project has now closed, there will in no further updates of the KiwImage product. Delivery is limited to the coverage contained in this MOU.

Product Descriptions

- 9. The **Data Custodian** will deliver data as it was supplied to the KiwImage project. The KiwImage project requested imagery in accordance with the specification contained in this MOU.
- 10. KiwImage is available in the three product types contained in this MOU.

End User Licence

- 11. When using data supplied by Digital Globe Inc, the Partner Agency agrees to abide by the terms and conditions of the Digital Globe Product Enter User Licence Agreement and the Deed modifying Digital Globe End User Licence Agreement dated 22 February 2008 [See page 15] of this MOU and attachments.
- 12. The Partner Agency must pay particular attention to (and abide by) the limitations contained in the End User License Agreement that restrict the Agency's use of Digital Globe's imagery. The Partner Agency must also comply with the source requirements specified in the End User Licence Agreement.
- 13. The Partner Agency will be responsible for the consequences of any non compliance with this Agreement and End User Licence Agreement and for non compliance by any person to whom the Partner Agency releases the KiwImage Data."







DEED MODIFYING DIGITALGLOBE END USER LICENCE

THIS DEED is made on the 22nd day of February 2008

BETWEEN HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN in the right of Her Government in New Zealand acting by and through the Chief of Defence Force ("NZDF") AND

DIGITALGLOBE INC a company incorporated under the laws of the United States of America and having its principle place of business at 1601 Dry Creek Dr., Suite 260, Longmont, CO 80503, United States of America (DigitalGlobe)

Background

- A. The NZDF wishes to enter into a contract with SINCLAIR KNIGHT MERZ PTY LIMITED (SKM) of MELBOURNE, AUSTRALIA for provision of digital imaging services pursuant to NZDF tender number 0701601 (the Request for Tender). SKM's tender includes an End User Licence Agreement (EULA) with DigitalGlobe which imposes certain terms and conditions which NZDF is unable to comply with.
- B. In consideration of NZDF entering into a contract with SKM, DigitalGlobe is prepared to alter its EULA terms in accordance with clause 12.f of the EULA by a binding written instrument.
- C. NZDF and DigitalGlobe have agreed to modify the EULA provision by entering into this Deed.

The Parties Agree

- This Deed includes DigitalGlobe's EULA annexed hereto as schedule 1.
- DigitalGlobe confirms that this Deed and the EULA will govern the use of DigitalGlobe's satellite imagery of the whole of New Zealand, selected South Pacific Islands, and areas of Antarctica, which is being supplied pursuant to the Contract.
- DigitalGlobe acknowledges that the NZDF is the lead agency in relation to the contract and that the digital imaging services will be distributed to Central, Regional, Local and other Government Agencies in New Zealand (the "Government") under license from DigitalGlobe.
- Pursuant to the use requirements the NZDF has requested under Part E, Sections 4.3 and 4.4 of the Request for Tender and DigitalGlobe agrees to make the following modifications and clarifications to the EULA:
 - For the purposes of DigitalGlobe's EULA, the "Customer Group" shall be all New Zealand Government sponsored organisations located within New Zealand.
 - "Internal Use" for the purpose of the EULA shall mean use within the "Customer Group" defined above – which means use by and within the Government and for the use of its consultants, contractors and agents, under supervision of the Government.
 - All derivative uses and products made from DigitalGlobe's imagery by the Government are to be non-commercial. They may be supplied to the public and displayed in organisations within the Customer Group specified above, but shall not be offered to the public for sale or as part of commercial offerings. The Government shall not undertake commercial projects using DigitalGlobe's imagery without DigitalGlobe's express approval.



- Any display of imagery on the Internet shall be made with source acknowledgements either by displaying DigitalGlobe's copyright or through an acknowledgement of DigitalGlobe's imagery in proximity to the website's display of a derivative work incorporating the imagery. However, DigitalGlobe will not require DigitalGlobe copyrights to be placed on vector products derived from the imagery, but which do not actually contain any portion of the imagery.
- The Government will continue to own any and all intellectual property that is combined with DigitalGlobe's imagery on any derivative works that the Government prepares.
- DigitalGlobe agrees to waive the Government's obligation to indemnify DigitalGlobe and hold it harmless as provided in Section 11 of the EULA.
- By accepting DigitalGlobe's imagery the NZDF confirms that the Government's use will conform to the above conditions, as well as the EULA that are unmodified by this agreement.
- This Deed may be executed and delivered in one or more counterpart copies (including by facsimile), each of which shall be deemed an original, and, when taken together, shall constitute a single instrument.

The Product and any Derivative Works may be posted to secure intranet websites and may be used only for the purposes of a Joint Project and subject to Section 3;
 - c. If you are a State and Local Government Agency, you may post the Product and Derivative Works on your website at full resolution for non-Commercial Purpose in a non-downloadable, non-distributable fashion and in a manner that does not allow a third party to extract or access the Product as a standeline file.
 - d. Make unlimited copies of the Product for internal use only;
 - Create Derivative Works for internal use, including reformating the Product into different formats or media from which it is

DigitalGlobe has the right to terminate this Agreement, effective immediately upon notice to you, if you breach any provision of this Agreement. Upon termination of this Agreement, all rights granted to you hereunder shall immediately cease.
