Dr Andres Katz is hosted by David Evison in the School of Forestry Faculty of Engineering in semester 1 2022. Dr Katz's area of expertise is forest economics and forest products marketing.

Where have you come from and what do you teach?

I am an independent consultant based in Auckland working mainly with the forest industry in the area of economics and sectoral modelling for forecasting and policy analysis.

What interested you in the Erskine Programme/Why did you want to come to UC?

The Erskine programme has given me the opportunity to re-connect with staff and students at the School of Forestry and give back to students some of what I enjoyed during my undergraduate studies at UC.
