Financial assistance to the value of \$5,000 for one year.	Applicants must be first-year undergraduate students intending to enrol full-time in a Bachelor of Commerce. Dependent on achievement of Merit or higher at NCEA Level 2, or an equivalent university entrance qualification. Applicants must be citizens of Aotearoa New Zealand or holders of Aotearoa New Zealand residence class visas. Up to 16 scholarships are available of which 4 are reserved for students with whakapapa Māori, and 2 are reserved for Pacific students.	6-Aug
<b>UC Business School Enterprise Scholarship</b>	The scholarship recognises outstanding students from the Waitaha Canterbury region who are involved in entrepreneurial activities and supports study in the first year of a programme for a BCom degree at UC.	Financial assistance to the value of \$5,000 for one year.	Applicants must be first-year undergraduate students intending to enrol in a Bachelor of Commerce and who are involved in entrepreneurial activities, either as an individual initiative, or through a school's Business Studies programme, the Young Enterprise Scheme, or some other entrepreneurship programme. Applicants must be resident and/or attending a school in the Waitaha Canterbury region. Applicants must be citizens of Aotearoa New Zealand or holders of Aotearoa New Zealand residence class visas.	6-Aug
<b>UC Kaupeka Ture   Faculty of Law First Year Award for Excellence</b>	The scholarship recognises academic and extracurricular achievement of students during their secondary education within Aotearoa New Zealand, and supports study in a programme for an LLB degree at UC. Applicants must be first-year undergraduate students intending to enrol full-time in a Bachelor of Laws degree taking at least 45 points from the LLB schedule. Applicants must be citizens of Aotearoa New Zealand or holders of Aotearoa New Zealand residence class visas. Up to 9 scholarships are available with 1 being reserved for a student with whakapapa Māori, and 1 being reserved for a Pacific student.	6-Aug
