MSD have approved types of ID:

- 1. Primary identity (government issued) which can include one of the following:
 - a. Passport
 - b. birth cert
 - c. drivers licence
- 2. 2 other types of proof of identity (only one document needs to be of at least 2 years old):
 - a. Bank statement (which would hopefully be 2 years old)
 - b. Letter from another Govt dept e.g. IRD (with IRD number)
 - c. 18+ card
 - d. Student ID card
 - e. Drivers licence (if not already used as primary identity).
 - f. Mobile ph account

The 3 forms must be certified by the following:

- JP or
- Local courthouse (no appt necessary) or
- Police station (no appt necessary)

- Reduced after hours medical fees
- Lower prescription fees
- Reduced fees for emergency dental care
- Reduced fee for X-rays and scans where ACC related
