Benefits (Fee-Paying Students Only)

1) Early Bird Promotion All students who register by October 16, 2025 and pay tuition by October 23, 2025 will recieve up to 15% discount.

Scholarships

3) APRU & AEARU Associate University Scholarship 100,000 KRW

All students enrolled at APRU and AEARU associate universities are eligible for the scholarship, which will be applied to their tuition fees.

4) Yonsei Alumni Scholarship 200,000 KRW

All students whose parents are graduates of Yonsei University are eligible to the Yonsei Alumni Scholarship.

The Center of Traditional and Youth Culture

Gwanghyewon

Established in remembrance of the founder of Yonsei University H.G. Underwood, it showcases the Underwood family residence as it appeared in the 1930s, displaying unpublished photos, videos, and books about Underwood's life.



Cheongsongdae Park

Often described as an on-campus oasis amidst the urban environment of Sinchon, Cheongsongdae Park offers students a peaceful retreat with space for relaxation and outdoor activities.
