NEXT STEPS:

- 1 Call NZQA on 0800 697 296 to find out how many credits you are missing, and in which subjects.
- 2 Contact Te Kura Correspondence School to find out if they can help you catch up. Once NCEA results are released UC will grant Provisional Admission to students who are catching up on 8 credits or less to meet the requirements of NCEA UE.
- 3 Forward your Te Kura Summer School enrolment confirmation email to provisional-admission@canterbury.ac.nz.
- 4 UC will calculate how many credits you are short of NCEA UE. If eligible, we will grant you Provisional Admission for the first two weeks of Semester 1 only. (Haven't applied to enrol at UC yet? Go to www.canterbury.ac.nz/enrol)
- 5 Submit your NCEA work to Te Kura Correspondence School before your UC courses start. If you have been given an earlier deadline by Te Kura, then please adhere to that.
- 6 Start your UC studies in February 2023.
- 7 Before the end of week 2 of Semester 1, UC will check your Te Kura Summer School results and determine if you will be granted full admission for the remainder of the semester.
