Schedule to the Regulations for the Diploma in Chinese Language (DipChinLang)

Note: The diploma normally includes courses at 100, 200 and 300-level in a single language. Courses selected will, however, be appropriate to the candidate's previous learning and experience. The diploma may include up to 0.34 ECTS in non-language courses from the Schedule to these regulations. The programme of study for all candidates must be approved by the Dean of Humanities and Social Sciences, who will be advised by the Programme Director of Chinese.
