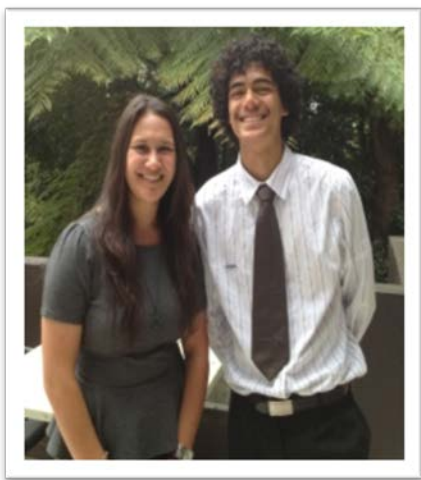

#### 4) Waikato-Tainui, Landcare Research and WINTEC - Wetland Restoration Studies (x2)

**2011 recipients:** Joshua Ormsby (Purekireki Marae) and Jonathan Brown (Maurea Marae)

**2012 recipient:** Rimutere Wharakura (Tuurangawaewae Marae)

**TWO Scholarships offered:** Full tuition fees only for a 1-year applied science qualification taught in the School of Engineering, Science and Primary Industries at WINTEC. Weekly work experience with one of our wetland science partners and/or the Department of Conservation

**Criteria:** Waikato-Tainui beneficiary, have attained 12 NCEA credits at Level 2 or equivalent in either Biology or Chemistry; and 12 NCEA credits at Level 2 or equivalent in one other science subject. Consideration will also be made for applicants over 20 years who may not have the relevant qualifications, but have relevant life experience, and/or a strong desire to succeed/passion for wetland and environmental restoration.

#### 5) Waikato-Tainui/Ministry for Culture and Heritage Intern Scholarship

**Criteria to apply:** Waikato-Tainui beneficiary, studying at a 2<sup>nd</sup> year or higher tertiary level towards a tertiary qualification in the field of Culture and Heritage, demonstrates academic ability and knowledge of Kiingitanga, the tribe and their marae.

#### 6) Waikato-Tainui/Waikato Regional Council Intern Scholarship (x2)
