

Te Whare Wānanga | The University

1. Constitution and Governance

- (a) Te Whare Wānanga o Waitaha | University of Canterbury is constituted by the University of Canterbury Act 1961 and the Education and Training Act 2020.
- (b) The University is a body corporate consisting of “the Council, the Professors Emeriti, the Professors, Lecturers, Registrar and Librarian, the graduates and undergraduates of the University and graduates of the University of New Zealand whose names are for the time being on the Register of the Court of Convocation of the University of Canterbury”, now the register of Graduates.
- (c) This constitution recognises the University as a community of scholars.
- (d) The Education and Training Act 2020 establishes:
 - i. Te Kaunihera | University Council as the governing body of the University; with responsibilities for approving the strategic direction and regulation of the University, the appointment of Te Tumu Whakarae | Vice-Chancellor, and the establishment of Te Poari Akoranga | Academic Board.
 - ii. Te Tumu Whakarae | Vice-Chancellor; empowered with the management of the affairs of the University as delegated by the Council.
 - iii. Te Poari Akoranga | Academic Board.
- (e) Te Kaunihera | Council has established the following committees:
 - i. Council Executive;
 - ii. Finance, Planning and Resources;
 - iii. Audit and Risk;
 - iv. Appeals;
 - v. Honours and Appointment;
 - vi. Vice-Chancellor Employment.

2. Management and Structure

- (a) The University is managed by Te Tumu Whakarae | Vice-Chancellor with advice from Te Ohu Whakahaere | Senior Leadership Team, University Committees and others as the Vice-Chancellor decides.
- (b) The University is composed of academic colleges, service divisions and Te Tari o te Tumu Whakarae | Vice-Chancellor's Office.
- (c) Te Tari o te Tumu Whakarae | Vice-Chancellor's Office includes the following officers:
 - i. Te Tumu Whakarae | Vice-Chancellor;
 - ii. Te Tumu Taurua Akoranga | Deputy Vice-Chancellor Academic;
 - iii. Te Tumu Taurua Rangahau | Deputy Vice-Chancellor Research;
 - iv. Te Pouroki | University Legal Counsel and Registrar;
 - v. Te Amokapua Pākākano | Assistant Vice-Chancellor Māori, Pacific and Equity.
- (d) Each college is managed by an Amorangi | Pro-Vice-Chancellor with advice from a College Management Team, the College faculty from College Meetings, and others as the Amorangi | Pro-Vice-Chancellor decides.
- (e) Each division is managed by a Kaihautū Matua | Executive Director with advice from heads of service units and others as the Kaihautū Matua | Executive Director decides.
