Whakamāramatanga | Key Information

Rā whakamutunga Closing date	31 March
Whaipanga Value	Grants from an annual fund of \$2,500 are available.
Herenga tika Applicable enrolment/programmes	A health-related programme.

1. Aronga | Purpose

The bursary supports students at Te Whare Wānanga o Waitaha | University of Canterbury in health-related programmes.

2. Paearu māraurau | Eligibility criteria

Applicants must be enrolled, or intending to enrol in the year following the year of application, full-time or part-time at the University in a health-related programme.

3. Tukanga tononga | Application process

3.1 Applications must be made online at the Scholarships website¹ by 31 March.

3.2 Applications are accepted from previous recipients of the grant. All applications are given equal consideration.

4. Tukanga kōwhiringa | Selection process

4.1 Grants from an annual fund of \$2,500 are available.

4.2 The bursary is awarded by Te Kaunihera | University Council on the recommendation the Tumu Whakarae | Vice-Chancellor (or nominee).

5. Paearu kōwhiringa | Selection criteria

5.1 In making the recommendation(s), the selection committee gives equal consideration to:

- character;
- financial need; and
- academic achievement.

5.2 In recommending a value for a grant, financial need alone is considered.

5.3 If, in any year, there is no suitable candidate, no grant is made.

6. Mahere utu | Value and payment schedule

The grant is paid by direct credit to a recipient's nominated Aotearoa New Zealand bank account on confirmation of enrolment in a health-related programme at the University.

7. Paearu here | Tenability

Co-tenure with any other award is permitted only with the permission of the Amo Rangahau | Dean of Postgraduate Research (or nominee).

8. Whakamahuki | Background information

The fund for this bursary was established in 1961 by a bequest under the will of Gertrude Ardagh Holmes.
